A. Technology and Research Park Update –

Mr. Baroody updated the EDA that the Technology and Research Center Board is working toward an incubator located in the same building as the Center. The Tech Center board will ask the Stafford Board of Supervisors to fund a \$300,000 - 3 year Mason Enterprise Center incubator on August, 19. The draft risk assessment should be completed in August, the full strategic plan is on track to conclude end of 2014.

The total cost of the event was \$11,976.31; \$8,500 from sponsors, leaving the cost to the EDA being \$3,476.31.
